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Gitoqlok's whole interface moves into the Chrome side panel, so local changes, the documentation wizard, reload tasks and the glossary sit beside the app you are committing from rather than vanishing when you click away. The popup has been redesigned to match, local changes gains change groups and object type icons, glossary terms link straight to Qlik Cloud, and tables move to a new filterable grid. Ask AI can now be governed centrally through managed browser policy.

WHAT'S NEW

Side Panel

The whole interface now runs in the Chrome side panel, not just the popup: local changes, import, documentation wizard, QSDA Pro, reload tasks, glossary and tools. A popup closes the moment you click back into the app, which made longer tasks awkward, so the side panel keeps your pending changes open beside the sheet you are working on.

Change Banner

An application has changed banner appears when the app is modified in Qlik, so you learn that the app has moved on while you are still in the extension rather than at commit time.

Popup Redesign

The popup has been redesigned to match the side panel, so the two read as one interface rather than two. A customisable tab layout sets which tabs appear and in what order, and a use side panel by default option sends the extension straight to the panel.

Local Changes

Local changes gains better change groups, tooltips for data connections and automations, and object type icons in the commit list. You can tell what kind of object each pending change touches from the list itself, before staging it.

New Data Grid

Every table has moved to a new grid with header filters, expandable details and a single scrollbar. Long commit and object lists can be narrowed from the header rather than scrolled through.

Glossary Links

Glossary term names now link straight to the Qlik Cloud glossary, so a term can be opened at its source without going to find it in the hub.

Enterprise AI Policy

Administrators can disable Ask AI, restrict which AI providers are available, or enforce an organisation-issued API key, all through managed browser policy. Because it is applied as browser policy, an organisation's AI position is set centrally instead of configured browser by browser.

FIX

- The documentation wizard no longer closes the popup or side panel when performing its actions.
