

QSDA Pro can now sit behind a reverse proxy: an optional URL base path is configurable in the Control Panel. The app list stays interactive while a large list loads and remembers its expand and collapse state. Fixes cover a misreported calc time collection status and dark mode text in the Script Generator.

WHAT'S NEW

Base Path

An optional URL base path, or context, can be configured under Control Panel, Configuration, Service Parameters. Use it when QSDA is reached through a reverse proxy.

App List

The app list allows interaction while a large list is still being fetched, and its expand and collapse state is restored when you return to it from another page.

FIXES

- A recoverable error during calc time collection was incorrectly reported as the final collection status.
- Dark mode: text was not visible in Script Generator dialogs.
